- Perform and support CASREP analysis, trends, FMECA, FRACAS, and other root cause processes. Provide additional expertise in preventative/corrective maintenance
- Analyze and forecast spare part requirements, maintenance activities, and operating costs using Reliability & Maintainability models
- Support the Configuration Management (CM) process by reviewing the technical and supportability aspects of Engineering Change Proposal (ECPs), waivers, and deviations.
- Review, analyze, and evaluate engineering analysis and studies, concept studies, system/platform integration, technical data, and feasibility studies
- Support Failure Review Boards (FRB), including FRB, Failure Response Team (FRT), and Failure Investigation Team (FIT) forums; and performing evidence collection, root-cause analyses, fault tree analysis, and make recommendations for findings and observations
- Assist in technology insertions/refreshment, support of Engineering Change Proposal (ECP) trade studies, ECP/Specification Control Drawing (SCD) reviews, development of solutions for operational and reliability issues, new development/major upgrades requirements/procedures, and data management
